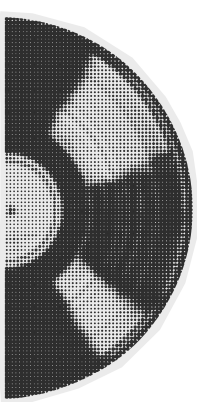

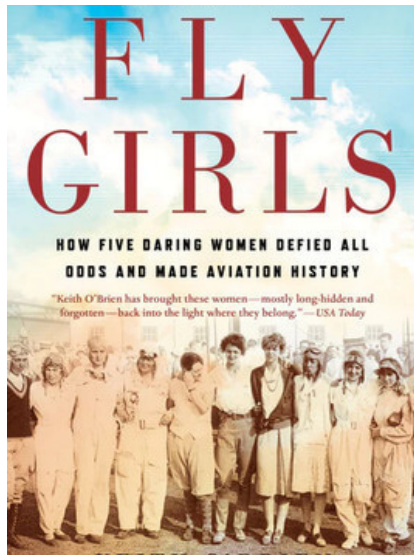

Target Shooting- Residents showed off their impressive focus, precision, and patience.

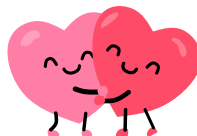
Bowling- had lots of strikes, spares and smiles.

Pet Therapy Spotlight: Aspen



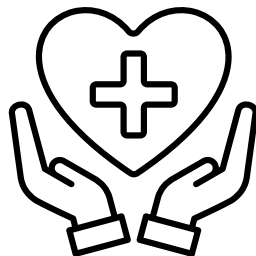
